

ANATOMY OF THE VIOLIN

The first violins were created in the early 16th century in Italy, but their ancestors go back much further: there is evidence that a string instrument played using a bow was developed in Ceylon before 3,000 BC. The Golden Age of the violin was the early 18th century when master craftsmen like Antonio Stradivari and Giuseppe Guarneri (del Gesu) produced the greatest violins in history. Yamaha is using state-of-the-art technology to study these instruments in order to create modern masterpieces like them.
