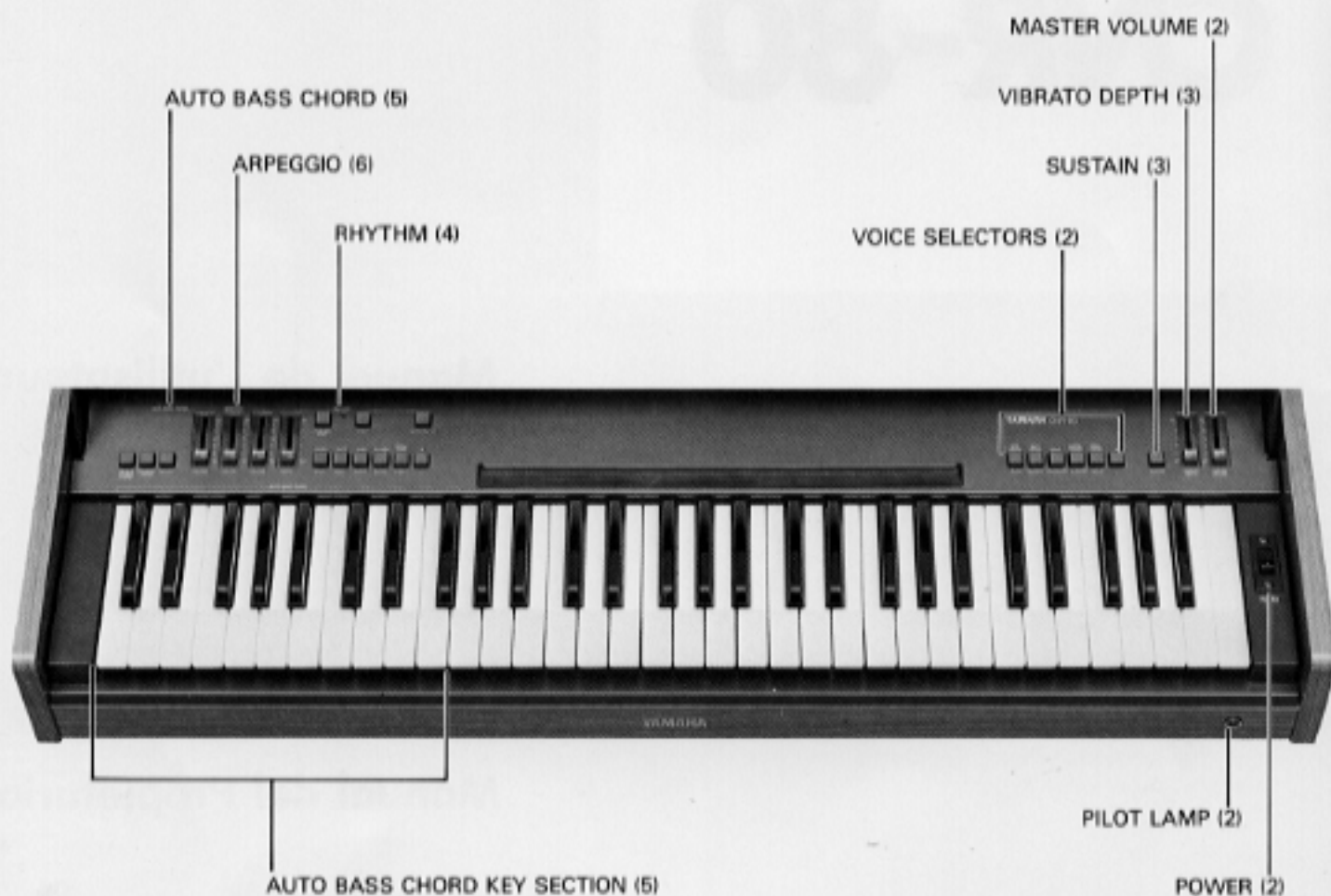

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing a Yamaha CNR-80.

This instrument offers you the following advanced functions and features:

- A voice section using the FM (Frequency Modulation) Tone Generation for 10 kinds of high-quality sounds.
- A rhythm section with realistic percussion sounds based on the FWM (Full Wave Memory) Digital Tone Generation.
- Functions such as Auto Bass Chord and Arpeggio, which make playing easier and more fun.
- 61 standard-size keys on a wide-range keyboard.

Please read this manual thoroughly as you play and experiment with the instrument.

## Einführung

Dieses Instrument bietet die folgenden fortschrittlichen Funktionen und Merkmale:

- Einen Stimmteil, der mittels FM (Frequenz-Modulation)-Tongenerator 10 qualitativ hochwertige Klänge erzeugt.
- Einen Rhythmusteil mit realistischen Schlaginstrumentklängen, die auf FWM (Vollwellenspeicher) Digital-Tonerzeugung basieren.
- Funktionen wie Auto-Bass-Akkorde und Arpeggio, die das Spielen leichter und erfreulicher machen.
- 61 Normaltasten auf einer breiten Tastatur.

## Introduction

- Une section rythme, avec des percussions "réalistes", basées sur la génération d'une tonalité numérique FWM (Full Wave Memory).
- Des fonctions telles que l'accord automatique des graves et des arpèges, ce qui facilite l'utilisation et ajoute de l'amusement.
- 61 touches de format standard sur un grand clavier.

- Sección de ritmos con sonidos de percusión realistas en la generación de tonos digitales de la FWM (memoria de onda completa).
- Funciones tales como acorde bajo y automático, y arpegio, que facilitan y hacen más divertida la ejecución.
- 61 teclas estándar en un teclado de amplia gama.

- Funktioner som Auto Bass Chord (automatiskt bas- och ackordackompanjering) och Arpeggio (automatiskt, brutet ackord), vilka gör det lättare och roligare för Dig att spela på orgeln.
- 61 tangenter i standardstorlek på den omfångsrika manualen.

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# BEFORE PLAYING

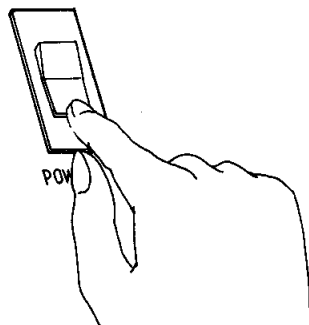
## Check for correct power voltage.

Consult your Yamaha serviceman regarding any changes. The power voltage is indicated on the nameplate at the back side.

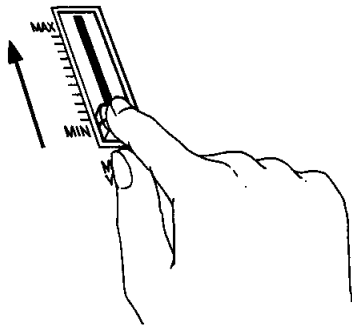
First of all, make sure that the plug is firmly inserted in the wall power outlet, then:

### 1) Turn on the POWER.

The power indicator lamp will light up.

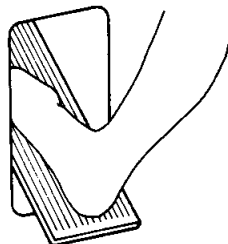


### 2) Slide the MASTER VOLUME control to the desired position.

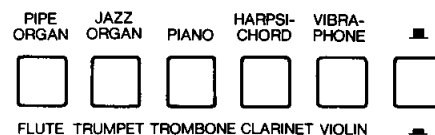


### 3) Depress the Expression Pedal.

The Expression Pedal is used to control volume during performance.



# TO START PLAYING



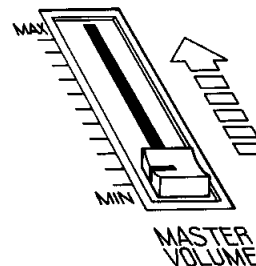
## VOICE SELECTORS

This organ can be played with 10 different voices.

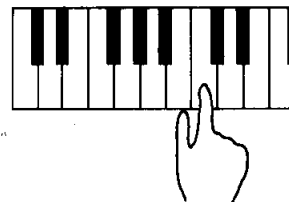
### 1) Press the selector corresponding to the instrument voice you want to hear.

When the rightmost selector is in the "up" position (▲), you can select the voices indicated in the top row. When it is in the "down" position (▼), you can choose from the bottom row of voices.

### 2) Adjust the volume level by sliding the MASTER VOLUME control.



### 3) Press a key on the keyboard.



You will hear the instrument voice you have selected. Try playing a simple melody which suits the voice.

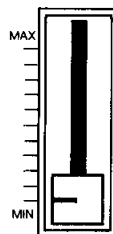
- ★ When two or more voice selectors are pressed simultaneously, the right-hand selector always has priority.
- ★ When no selector is depressed, the PIPE ORGAN voice will be automatically selected.



SUSTAIN

## SUSTAIN

The Sustain function gives the notes a natural or gradual fade-out after the keys have been released. A Sustain effect can be obtained by pressing the SUSTAIN button.



VIBRATO DEPTH

## VIBRATO DEPTH

Vibrato is a variation in pitch, a fluctuation above and below whatever note is being pressed. A Vibrato effect can be obtained by sliding the VIBRATO DEPTH control forward MAX.

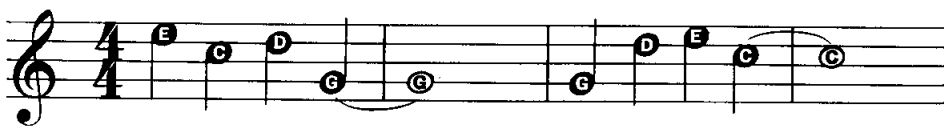
- ★ The Vibrato effect used in the CNR-80 is a delayed vibrato, meaning it will begin to be effective a short while after a key has been pressed.
- ★ The Vibrato effect cannot be used with the voices PIANO and HARPSICHORD.

# USING THE REALISTIC DRUMS

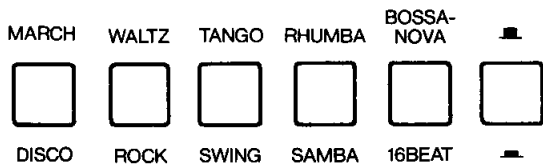


## RHYTHM

Now let's add a rhythm accompaniment to your melody.

### 1) Choose a rhythm.

Pick the rhythm which best suits the music you're going to play and press the selector.



When the rightmost selector is in the "up" position (■), you can select the rhythms indicated in the top row. When it is in the "down" position (▾), you can choose from the bottom row of rhythms.

### 2) Start the rhythm.

After selecting a rhythm, press the START selector.

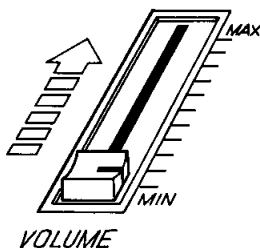


To stop the rhythm, press the START selector again.

### 3) Adjustments.

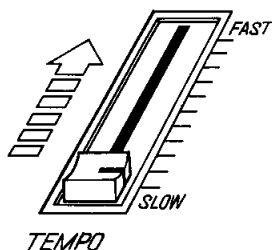
#### Volume

The Rhythm VOLUME control allows adjustment of the rhythm volume in relation to the melody volume.



#### Tempo

Use the TEMPO control to adjust the tempo of the rhythm.



### ● SYNCHRO START



The SYNCHRO START selector is used when you want to have the rhythm begin the moment a key is depressed. The first 19 keys on the left side of the keyboard, which are identified by the words AUTO BASS CHORD printed above the keys, will activate the rhythm sounds. When a key has been depressed in this section, the rhythm will continue until it is turned off by pressing the SYNCHRO START selector again.

### ● TEMPO LAMP

The Tempo Lamp functions as a visual metronome, making it simple for you to confirm the rhythm tempo when playing a melody. When a rhythm is activated, the lamp flashes at the first beat of every bar. When the SYNCHRO START selector is engaged but you have not yet started the rhythm by pressing a key, the Tempo Lamp flashes at every quarter note.

### ● AUTO FILL IN



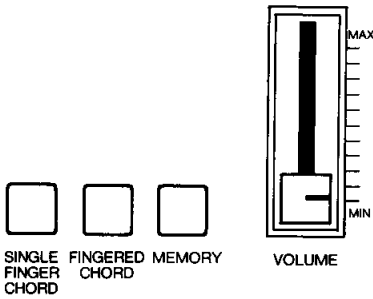
AUTO FILL IN

This function automatically changes the rhythm and accompaniment patterns after a certain number of measures. When this button is pressed to ON, the rhythm pattern is switched to a fill in pattern every 4 measures, while the chord, bass and arpeggio patterns are switched to fill in patterns every 8 measures.

- ★ When two or more voice selectors are pressed simultaneously, the right-hand selector always has priority.
- ★ When no selector is depressed, March will be automatically selected.

# ADDING BASS AND STRUMMING CHORDS

AUTO BASS CHORD



## AUTO BASS CHORD

The AUTO BASS CHORD is an automatic accompaniment feature. When the single finger chord selector is depressed, you can play three-note chords using a single finger. The FINGERED CHORD selector allows more experienced players to play their own chords while continuing to get the bass and rhythm back-up.

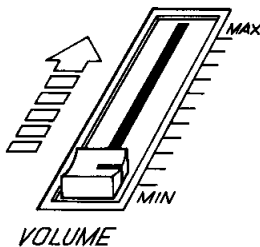
### SINGLE FINGER CHORD

1) Press the SINGLE FINGER CHORD selector.



2) Set the volume.

Adjust the volume to suit the overall level using the Auto Bass Chord's independent VOLUME control.

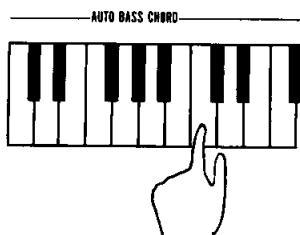


3) Select a rhythm.

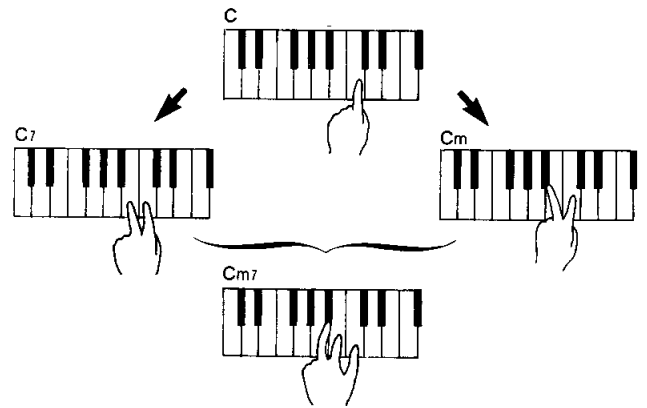
Choose the rhythm you want, then press the SYNCHRO START or START selector. (Don't forget to do this whenever you use the Auto Bass Chord feature)

4) Press a key.

Press one of the 19 keys in the Auto Bass Chord key section on the left side of the keyboard. You will hear the corresponding chord with bass and rhythm accompaniment. For instance, when you press "C" ("Do"), you'll obtain a C major chord that strums along with the bass and rhythm.



● **Obtaining minor, seventh and minor seventh chords.**  
You can play a total of 48 chords (4 types × 12) in Single Finger Chord mode.



- To get a C minor chord, depress the C key together with the next black key to the left.
- To get a C seventh chord, depress the C key together with the next white key to the left.
- To get a C minor seventh chord, simply press the C key together with the next black key and white key to the left.

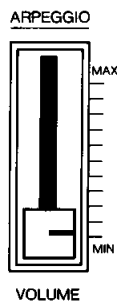
● **MEMORY**



MEMORY

This function is convenient when you change chords. If this selector is pressed when the Single Finger Chord or Fingered Chord mode is used, the bass pattern and the strumming chords will continue to play after you lift your finger(s) from the keys. Therefore, you only have to press the keys when you change chords. If you prefer to hold down chords, you must completely lift your finger(s) from the keys when you change from one chord to another, otherwise the chord will not change correctly.

- ★ When the AUTO FILL IN button in the rhythm section is pressed to ON, the chord and bass patterns are automatically switched to fill-in patterns every 8 measures. (See page 4.)
- ★ When the Auto Bass Chord feature is used without SYNCHRO START or START, you will get a continuous chord with bass.



## ARPEGGIO

This section provides an effect similar to those produced by an experienced keyboard player playing runs or progressions of notes up and down the keyboard in a rippling effect.

This effect can be activated when the Rhythm section and either the Single Finger Chord or Fingered Chord mode are being used. To use the Arpeggio effect, first play a note or a chord in the Auto Bass Chord key section. You will hear the Arpeggio by sliding the ARPEGGIO VOLUME control towards MAX. Adjust the sound level to your personal preference. To stop the Arpeggio effect, slide the lever to MIN.

★ *When the AUTO FILL IN button is pressed to ON, the arpeggio pattern is automatically switched to a fill-in pattern every 8 measures. (See page 4.)*

### FINGERED CHORD

- 1) Press the FINGERED CHORD selector.



FINGERED CHORD

- 2) Set the volume.
- 3) Select a rhythm.
- 4) Press a chord.

When a combination of keys located in the Auto Bass Chord key section are pressed, the resulting chord will be played together with the automatic accompaniment consisting of the bass line and the selected rhythm.

- ★ *In the Fingered Chord mode, the following chords can be played: major, minor, seventh, minor seventh, minor seventh flatted fifth, seventh suspended fourth.*

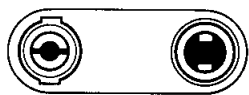

## ACCESSORY JACKS

### ● HEADPHONES jack

This jack is used for connecting a pair of monaural headphones. When the headphones are connected, no sound will be produced from the CNR-80's speaker. This allows you the freedom to enjoy playing your instrument at any time without disturbing others. You can also use this jack for connecting stereo headphones.

### ● AUX. OUT jack

This jack is used to connect an amplifier or tone cabinet when a more powerful volume is needed for a performance. Also, by connecting it with the line-in jack of a tape deck, you can record music produced by the CNR-80.

## IMPORTANT ADVICE

What to do if.....

### 1) The unit is not activated when the power is turned on. Check the following:

Is the AC plug fully connected to a wall power outlet? Connect it again to make sure. Is power supplied from the outlet? If the outlet is live but the organ does not work, unplug the cord and contact your Yamaha dealer.

### 2) The organ reproduces radio or TV signals.

This can occur if there is a powerful transmitter such as a radio station located in your vicinity. Contact your Yamaha dealer.

### 3) Occasional unpleasant static occurs.

In the majority of such cases, the cause can be traced to the turning on or off of the refrigerators, washing machines, electric pumps or other household appliances. Electrical faults in a nearby outdoor neon sign may also be a cause.

### 4) The CNR-80's sound interferes with radio or TV reception.

A high frequency pulse used for the sound source of the organ may adversely affect TV or radio reception. Therefore, play your organ as far away as possible from TV and radio sets.

### 5) Rattling (sympathetic vibration) occurs.

All materials have critical resonance frequencies at which they vibrate. The organ's continuous tones will naturally cause other objects (windows, objects on shelves, etc) to vibrate.

Change the place of installation whenever such a difficulty occurs.

## LOOKING AFTER YOUR CNR-80

Always treat your organ with the same care you would any fine musical instrument.

The following points are suggested to ensure the best performance of this organ.

- 1) A supply voltage selector is fitted to the CNR-80 in certain markets. Check for the correct power, and also for correct setting of the voltage selector. Consult your Yamaha serviceman regarding any changes.
- 2) Always turn the power OFF after playing.
- 3) Your organ contains no user serviceable components. Refer all service to qualified service technicians only.
- 4) Clean the organ cabinet with a damp cloth containing a neutral cleaning detergent. Use only a soft, dry cloth on the keyboard. Never use paint thinner, alcohol or other chemicals on either the keys or the cabinet.
- 5) The finish on your organ may undergo a chemical reaction if placed in direct contact with polyvinyl products. Do not set vinyl items on the surface or use polyvinyl material to cover the organ for any extended period of time.
- 6) Keep the organ in a location away from direct sunlight, excessive humidity and heat to protect the cabinet finish.
- 7) Do not bump or scratch the cabinet with hard objects.

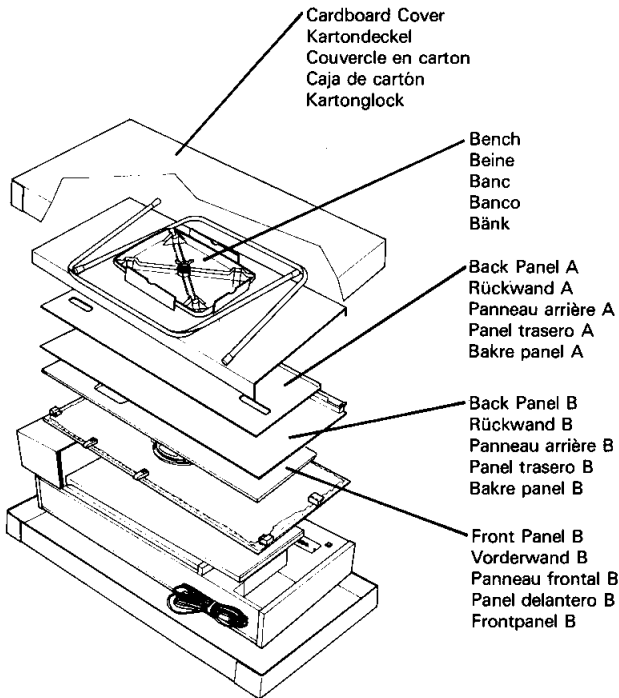

## 1) COMPONENT PARTS

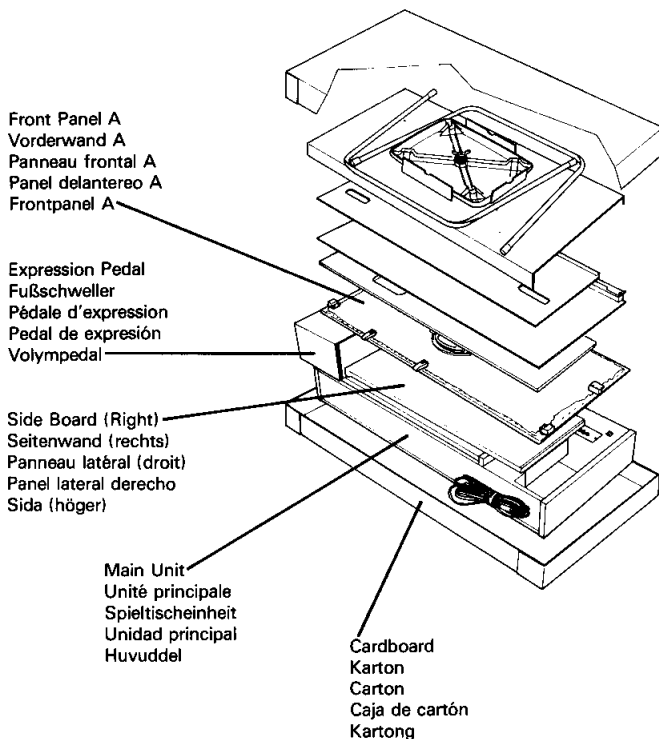
The carton contains the parts shown in the figure below. Before assembling, remove the cardboard cover placed on the top.

## 1) EINZELTEILE

Der Karton enthält die unten abgebildeten Einzelteile. Entfernen Sie zum Auspacken den Deckel.

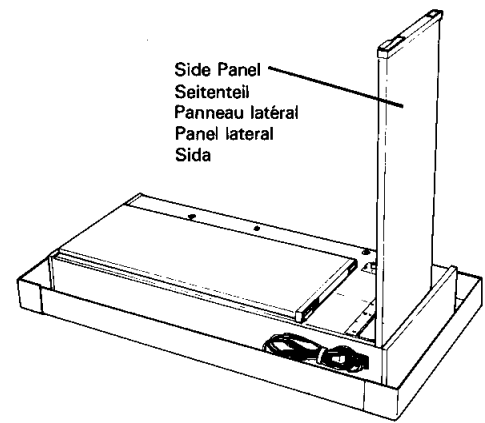
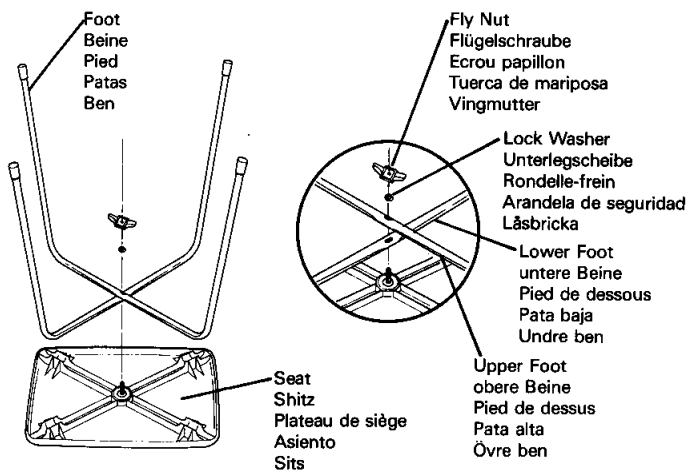


## 1) PIEZAS

La caja de cartón contiene las piezas indicadas en la ilustración siguiente. Antes de armar, quite el cartón corrugado colocado en la parte superior.

## 1) INGÅENDE DELAR

Kartongen innehåller de delar som visas på bilden ovan. Lyft först av kartonglocket före monteringen.



## 2) ASSEMBLING BENCH

Take the parts of Bench (Seat & Foot) off.  
Take Fly Nuts and Lock Washer off.  
Put the two Feet onto Screws of the Seat and then fasten them with Lock Washer and Fly Nut, each in turn.

## 3) ASSEMBLING THE SIDE PANELS

Remove the side panel cover and raise both the right and left side panels.

## 2) ZUSAMMENBAU DER SITZBANK

Nehmen Sie den Sitz und die Beine heraus.  
Lösen Sie die Flügelmutter und entfernen Sie die Unterlegscheibe.  
Setzen Sie die Beine auf die Schraube, legen Sie die Unterlegscheibe darauf und ziehen Sie die Flügelschraube fest.

## 3) MONTAGE DER SEITENWÄNDE

Entfernen Sie die Verpackung der Seitenteile. Richten Sie das rechte und linke Seitenteil auf.

## 2) ASSEMBLAGE DU BANC

Sortir les pièces qui composent le banc (siège et pieds).  
Enlever l'écrou papillon et la rondelle-frein.  
Placer les deux pieds sur les vis du plateau de siège et les fixer alternativement au moyen de leurs rondelles-frein et de leurs écrous papillon respectifs.

## 3) ASSEMBLAGE DES PANNEAUX LATÉRAUX

Prendre les 2 panneaux latéraux et les mettre debout après avoir retiré les caches latéraux.

## 2) MONTAJE DEL BANCO

Desempaque las piezas del banco (asiento y patas).  
Quite la palometa y la arandela de seguridad.  
Coloque las patas en el tornillo del asiento y asegúrelas con la arandela y la palometa.

## 3) MONTAJE DE LOS PANELES LATERALES

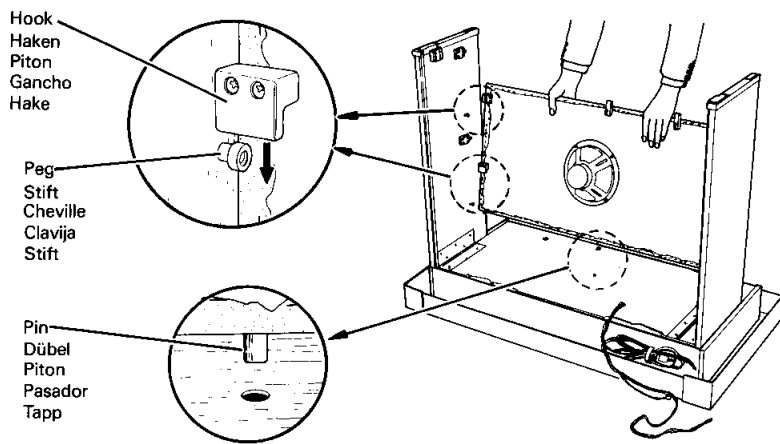
Extraiga la cubierta de los paneles laterales y alce ambos paneles.

## 2) MONTERING AV BÄNK

Tag ur delarna till bänken (sits och ben).  
Tag bort vingmuttern och brickan.  
Trä de två benen över skruven och fäst dem med låsbrickan och vingmuttern.

## 3) MONTERING AV SIDOR

Tag bort förpackningen från sidorna och res upp både höger och vänster sidor.



#### 4) ASSEMBLING THE FRONT PANEL [A]

Hook the front panel over the right and left panel pegs, and insert the front-panel pin into the corresponding hole in the shelf panel as shown in the illustration.

Finally, insert the lock unit into the lock block until it is locked firmly.

#### 4) MONTAGE DER LAUTSPRECHERPLATTE [A]

Haken Sie die Lautsprecherplatte über die Stifte am rechten und linken Seitenteil ein und stecken Sie den Zapfen der Lautsprecherplatte wie in der Abbildung gezeigt in das Loch der Spieltischeinheit (Unterseite).

Schieben Sie zum Schluß die Befestigungseinheit in den Befestigungsblock, bis sie fest verbunden ist.

#### 4) ASSEMBLAGE DU PANNEAU FRONTAL [A]

Accrocher le panneau frontal sur les chevilles droite et gauche et insérer le piton du panneau frontal dans la cavité correspondante située sur la tablette, comme indiquée sur le schéma.

Insérer enfin l'unité de verrouillage dans le bloc de verrouillage jusqu'à ce qu'il se bloque convenablement.

#### 4) MONTAJE DEL PANEL DELANTERO [A]

Enganche el panel delantero en las clavijas de los paneles laterales derecho e izquierdo, e inserte el pasador del panel delantero en el orificio correspondiente del estante como se ilustra.

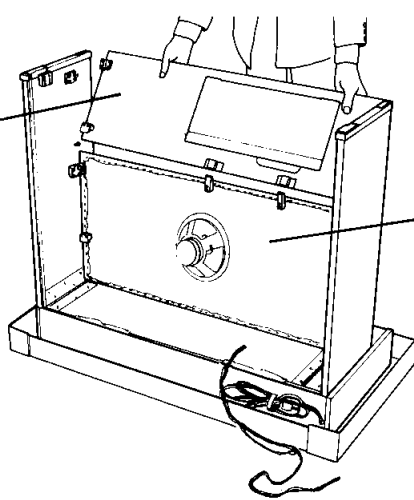

#### 4) MONTERING AV FRONTPANEL [A]

Haka frontpanelen över höger och vänster sidostift och passa in tappen i motsvarande hål såsom visas på illustrationen. Se slutligen till att låsen knäpper igen ordentligt.

### 5) ASSEMBLING THE FRONT PANEL [B]

The hooks on both ends of the Front Panel (B) are aligned with the side pegs. At the same time the two central catches are inserted into the latch on the front panel (A).

Finally, insert the lock unit into the lock block until it is locked firmly.

### 5) MONTAGE DER LAUTSPRECHERPLATTE [B]

Bringen Sie die Schnappverschlüsse an beiden Enden der Lautsprecherplatte mit den Gegenstücken (Seitenteilen) zur Deckung und lassen Sie sie fest einrasten.

Schieben Sie zum Schluß die Befestigungseinheit in den Befestigungsblock, bis sie fest verbunden ist.

### 5) ASSEMBLAGE DU PANNEAU FRONTAL [B]

Les crochets situés aux extrémités du panneau frontal (B) correspondent aux chevilles latérales. De même, les 2 attaches centrales s'insèrent dans le loquet du panneau frontal.

Insérer enfin l'unité de verrouillage dans le bloc de verrouillage jusqu'à ce qu'il se bloque convenablement.

### 5) MONTAJE DEL PANEL DELANTERO [B]

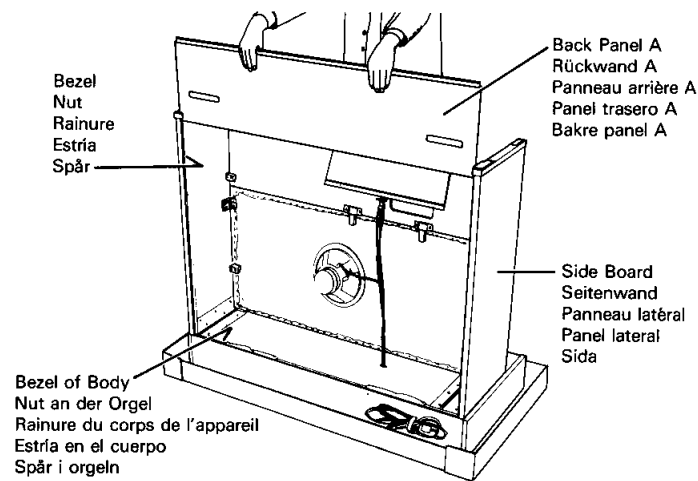
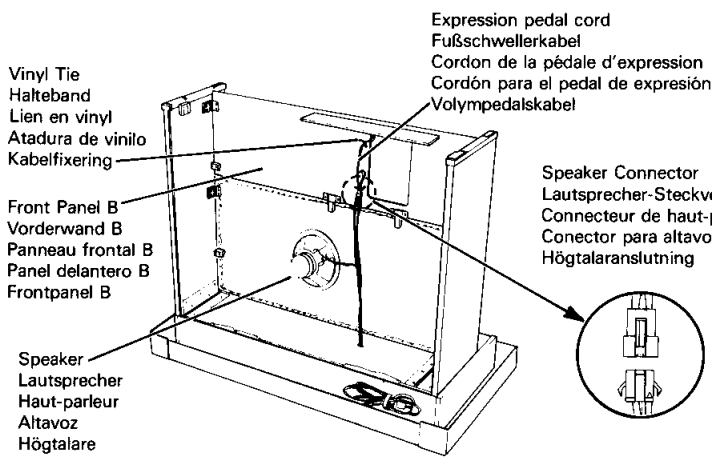
Los ganchos de ambos extremos del panel delantero (B) están alineados con las clavijas laterales. Al mismo tiempo, los dos pestillos centrales se hallan insertados en las hembras de la cerradura del panel delantero (A).

### 5) MONTERING AV FRONTPANEL [B]

Hakarna på båda sidor på frontpanel B passas in över stiften. Samtidigt passas de två pinnarna och öglorna på mitten i varandra mot frontpanel A. Se slutligen till att låsen knäpper igen ordentligt.

Montera slutligen låsanordningen i låsblocket. Se till att den fästs ordentligt.



## 6) FIXING CORD

Insert the Speaker Connector as illustrated. Raise the Bottom Panel and fasten the cord with vinyl ties as shown in the illustration.

## 7) ASSEMBLING BACK PANELS

Put Back Panel (A) into the left and right bezel of Side Board and fix it as illustrated.

At this time, check that Back Panel is properly put into the bezel.

## 6) BEFESTIGEN DES KABELS

Schließen Sie die Lautsprecherklemme wie abgebildet an. Heben Sie die Bodenplatte an und befestigen Sie das Kabel mit den Kabelhaltern wie in der Abbildung gezeigt.

## 6) CORDON DE RACCORDEMENT

Insérer le connecteur d'enceintes acoustiques de la manière indiquée sur l'illustration. Soulever le panneau inférieur et serrer le cordon avec des attaches en vinyle de la manière indiquée sur l'illustration.

## 7) MONTAGE DES PANNEAUX ARRIERES

Placer le panneau arrière (A) dans les rainures des panneaux latéraux gauche et droit et le bloquer en place comme illustré. Vérifier alors que le panneau arrière est bien en place dans la rainure du corps de l'appareil.

## 6) CABLE DE FIJACIÓN

Inserte el conector del altavoz de la forma ilustrada. Suba el panel inferior y ate el cable con las amarras de vinilo, como se muestra en la ilustración.

## 7) MONTAJE DE LOS PANELES TRASEROS

Introduzca el panel trasero A en las estrías de los paneles laterales y del cuerpo.

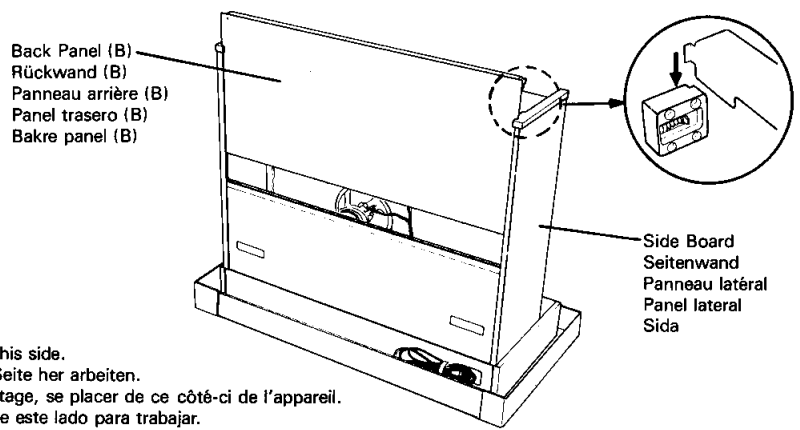
Entonces, compruebe que el panel trasero esté colocado correctamente en la ranura.

## 6) FIXERA KABLAR

Anslut högtalarna enligt illustrationen. Lyft upp bottenplattan och fixera kablarn såsom bilden visar.

## 7) MONTERING AV BAKRE PANELER

Skjut in bakre panel (A) i spårerna på höger och vänster sidor enligt illustrationen. Var noga med att båda sidor går i spåret.

- ★ Pay attention to both sides of Back Panel.

 Insert Back Panel (B) into the bezel of Back Panel (A) and lock it in place with the three retainers on the base.  
 Check whether Back Panel (B) can be drawn up or not.  
 (When it can not be drawn up, that means the locking is perfect.)

- ★ Achten Sie auf die beiden Seiten der Rückwand. (Setzen Sie die Rückwand so ein, daß die rauhe Seite nach innen gerichtet ist.)

Führen Sie die Rückwand B in die Nut der linken und rechten Seitenwand ein.

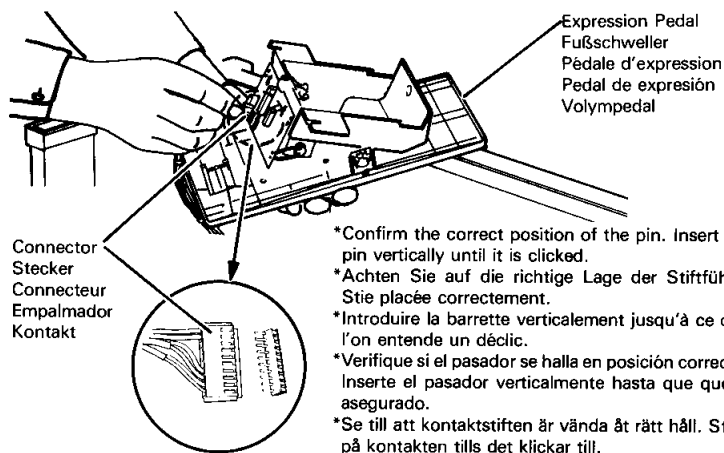
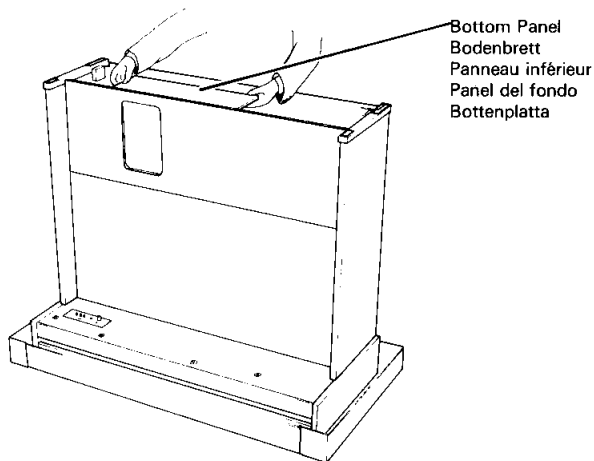

### 9) FIXING CORD FOR WIRING EXPRESSION PEDAL

As illustrated, take off Cord for wiring Expression Pedal which has been fixed in step 6, and connect Expression Pedal Cord to Expression Pedal.

- \* Confirm the correct position of the pin. Insert the pin vertically until it is clicked.
- \* Achten Sie auf die richtige Lage der Stifführer Stie placée correctement.
- \* Introduire la barrette verticalement jusqu'à ce que l'on entende un dé clic.
- \* Verifique si el pasador se halla en posición correcta. Inserte el pasador verticalmente hasta que quede asegurado.
- \* Se till att kontaktstiften är vända åt rätt håll. Stick på kontakten tills det klickar till.

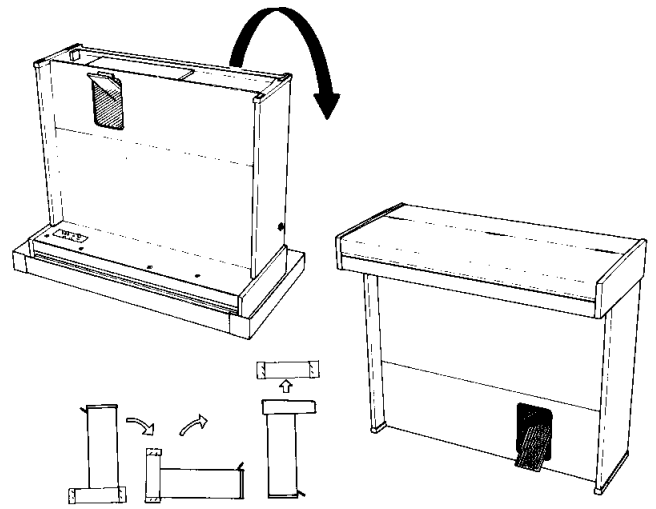
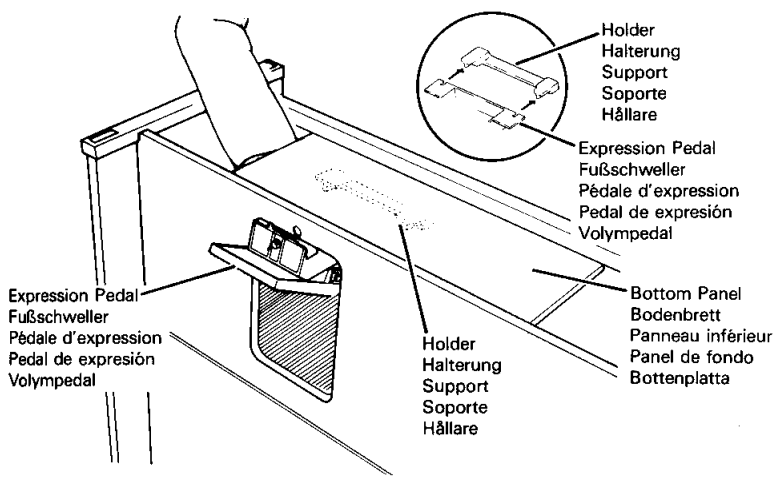

- ★ Connection of cord must be done without tangling the cord.

### 11) COMPLETION DIAGRAM

After completing the assembly, set up the organ as shown in the figure below.

Hold the lid and lift it up in the direction of the arrow.

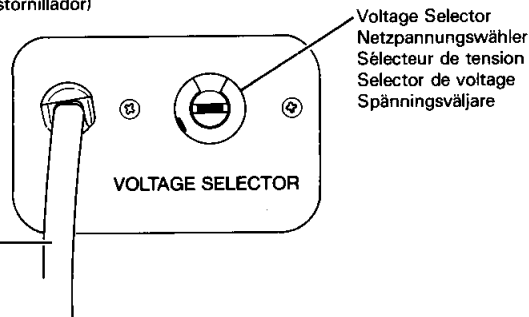

- ★ If you move to an area where the power supply voltage is different, be sure to reset the Voltage Selector to the correct position for the voltage in that area. Please check with the nearest Yamaha dealer for details.
- ★ If no voltage selector has been fitted, the operating voltage of your CNR-80 has been preset to the supply voltage in your area. Just make sure that you connect your plug properly to your AC supply outlet.
